Red Ribbon Week: Hillsborough schools will be celebrating the Red Ribbon Campaign October 24th-28th. The Red Ribbon Campaign is the oldest and largest drug prevention program in the nation and a way for people and communities to take a visible stand against drugs. This year's theme, "YOLO. Be Drug Free.", created by two 6th graders in Claysburg, PA, is a wonderful, positive message to share – we invite you to join us. HES will celebrate Red Ribbon Week with the following spirit days:
